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District Safety Program

The District Superintendent continues to conduct a series of Tail-Gate safety meetings during the week to keep employees mindful of safety precautions and the proper operation of equipment. Safety meetings were conducted on:

- Step Ladder Safety Training
- Common Safety Mistakes
- Ergonomic Safety Training
- Annual Fire Extinguisher Safety Training (Conducted by Jorgensen's)

Maintenance Operations

Under the direction of Wayne Fox, District Superintendent, staff addressed maintenance concerns throughout the District.

The major maintenance projects include:

- Doze bottom of ditches and canals
- Replacement of Evans Ditch culvert at Road 268
- Tree trimming along District canals and ditches
- Sand removal from canals and ditches
- Canal debris removal prior to storm events
- Grading District canals and basins
- Remove debris on Ketchum with excavator

Vehicle Maintenance Program

The Vehicle Maintenance staff (VM Staff) has been busy maintaining and repairing construction and maintenance equipment. The maintenance issues that have been addressed include:

- Standard repairs on maintenance truck fleet
- Standard service of construction equipment and trucks
- Repair of small dump truck bed
- Repair air brake system on dump truck

Herbicide Application Program

The Herbicide Application Staff (Herbicide Staff) has been working on applying herbicide chemicals to District canal embankments.
