District Safety Program

The District Superintendent continues to conduct a series of Tail-Gate safety meetings during the week to keep employees mindful of safety precautions and the proper operation of equipment. Safety meetings were conducted on:

Maintenance Operations

The major maintenance projects include:

- District Basin Shaping (No.6 Basin)
- Disc basin with Big JD tractor
- Repair district turnouts and screens
- Repair canal wash-ins
- Removal on tires and trash from canals
- Spring yard cleanup
- Finish grading canals
- Push in Miot ditch at Richard Dyt's

Vehicle Maintenance Program

The Vehicle Maintenance staff (VM Staff) has been busy maintaining and repairing construction and maintenance equipment. The maintenance issues that have been addressed include:

- Standard repairs on maintenance truck fleet
- Standard service of construction equipment and trucks
- 90 day DOT inspections on Fleet
- Repairs to Engineer tech truck

Herbicide Application Program

The Herbicide Application Staff (Herbicide Staff) has been working on applying herbicide chemicals to District canal embankments.
