

District Safety Program

The District Superintendent continues to conduct a series of Tail-Gate safety meetings during the week to keep employees mindful of safety precautions and the proper operation of equipment. Safety meetings were conducted on:

Code of Safe Practices

Maintenance Operations

Under the direction of Wayne Fox, District Superintendent, staff addressed maintenance concerns throughout the District.

The major maintenance projects include:

- Mowing operations for Evans Ditch Co. and Tulare Irrigation Co.
- Grading of canals for Evans Ditch Co. and Tulare Irrigation Co.
- Begin grading operations within District
- Dredging and hauling of sediment accumulation in ditches and canals
- Inspection of turnouts and culverts
- Removal of trees and brush material from Lemos Ditch
- Miscellaneous trash and debris removal from canals
- Discing of Swall and Liberty Basins
- Repair miscellaneous wash-ins

Vehicle Maintenance Program

The Vehicle Maintenance staff (VM Staff) has been busy maintaining and repairing construction and maintenance equipment. The maintenance issues that have been addressed include:

- Standard repairs and maintenance on truck fleet
- 90-day DOT inspections and repairs
- Daily repairs to ditchtender trucks
- Repairs to District yard irrigation system

Herbicide Application Program

The Herbicide Application Staff (Herbicide Staff) has been working on applying herbicide chemicals to District canal embankments. Herbicide staff provided contact spray operations for Evans Ditch Co. and Tulare Irrigation Co. The Herbicide Staff also conducted copper sulfate applications in District canals.

The following chemicals were used at the specified rates:
